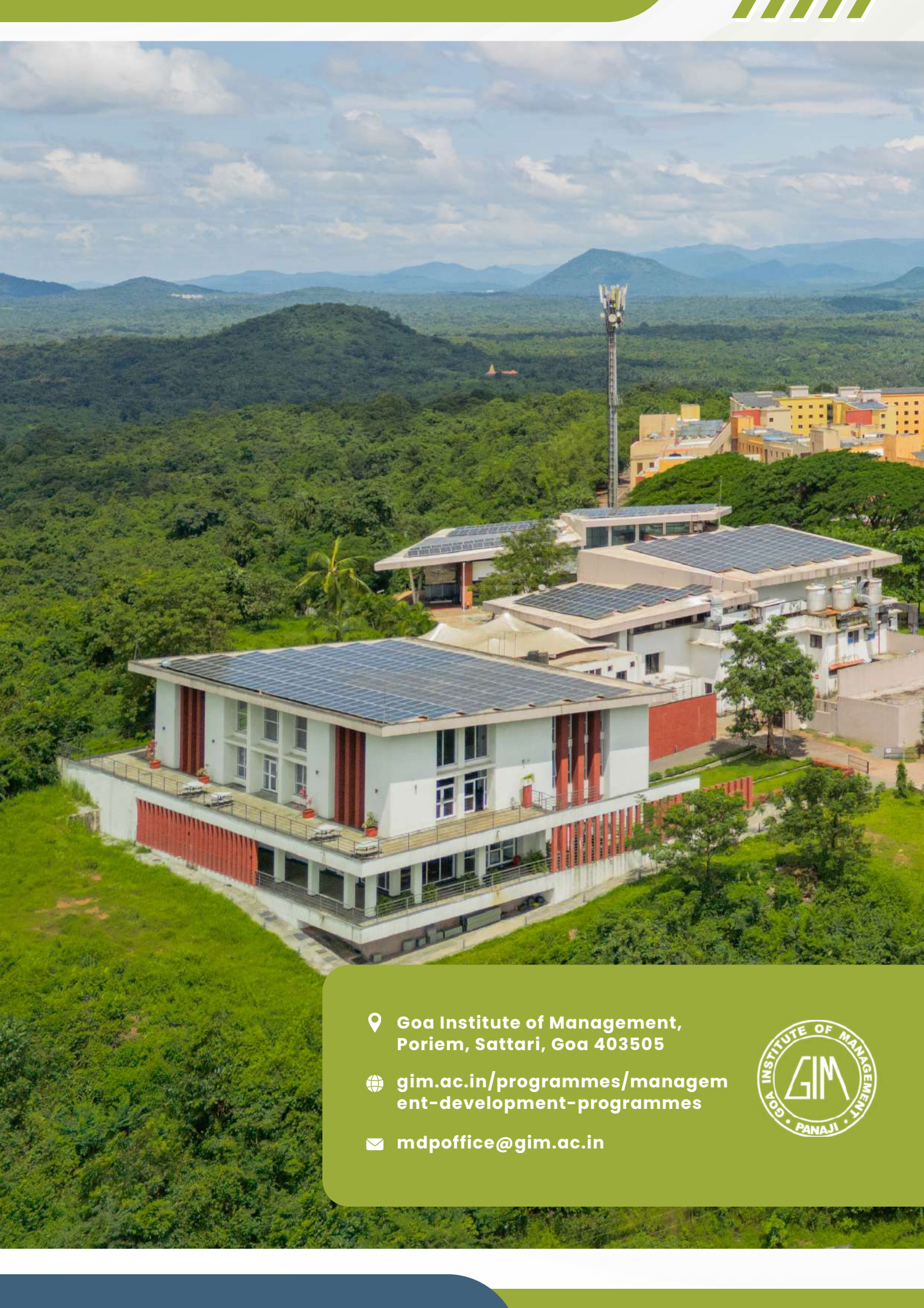


DR. PRANUSHA KULKARNI
